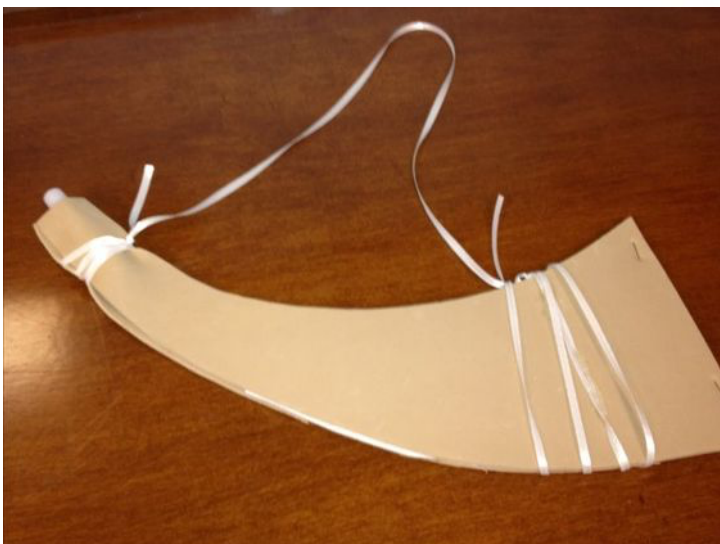

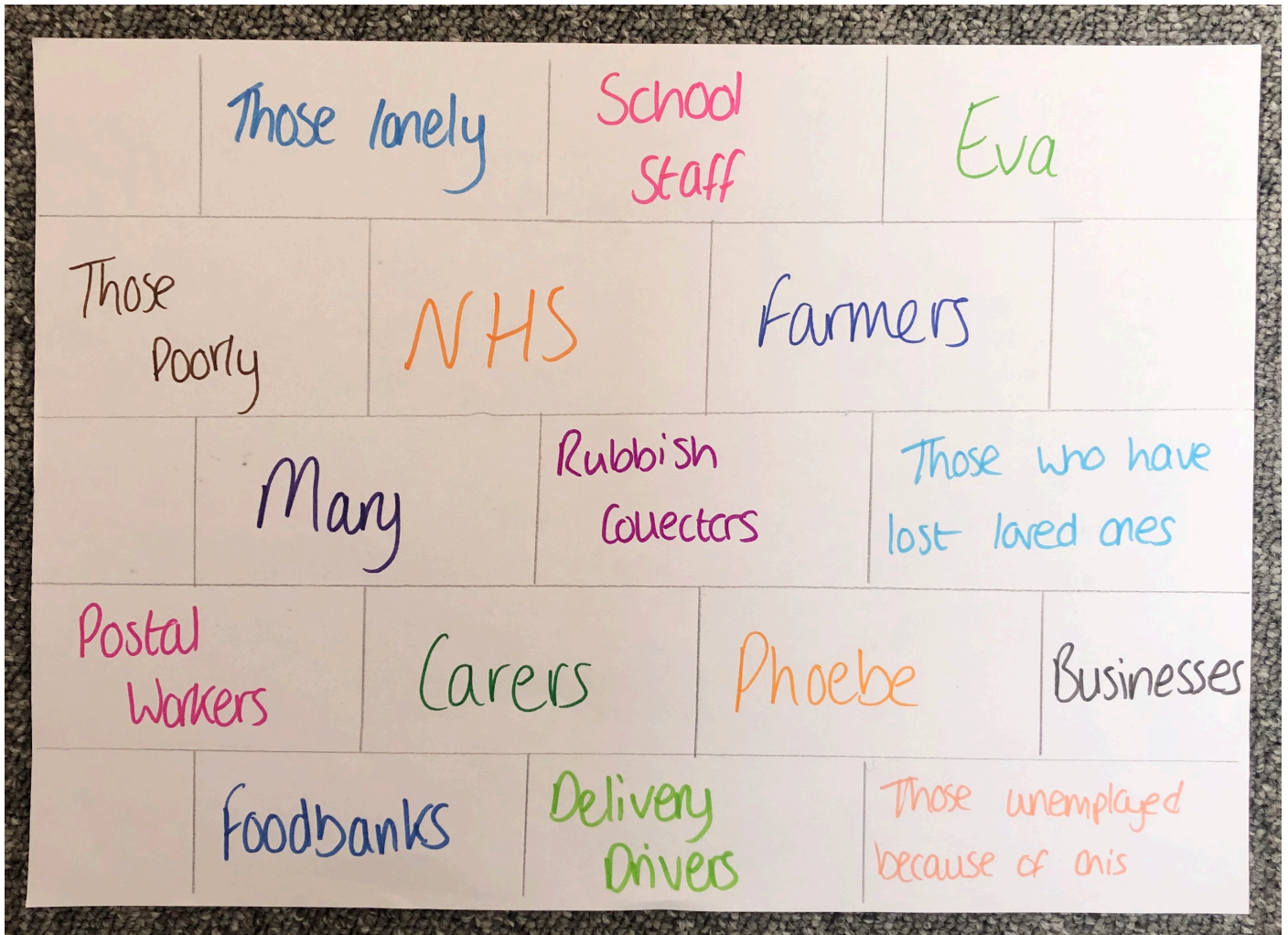
Craft
