We are all very aware that the cost of living - food, petrol, diesel, gas, electricity - has increased and will continue to do so, for some time. Even in our three relatively affluent villages, people are experiencing financial challenges. For some in Doncaster, the reality will be 'Eat or Heat'. In 2022 this is a sad state of affairs and as a Church we are called to help the vulnerable in our society. To be social activists.

St John the Evangelist, in Balby, runs "Given Freely Freely Given", they offer food bank, clothing bank and other support and they desperately need our help with the following:

- **Food** - *non perishables such as pot noodles, tin soup, beans, spaghetti, mince, meat balls, peas, carrots*
- **Toiletries** - *any but we prefer soap rather than shower gel and shampoo as reduces the use of plastics*
- **All Bedding and Towels**
- **Clothes** - *any, but we are desperate for mens*
- **Small household items** *such as pots, pans, cutlery, small lamp shades, plates, mugs, cups, saucers, plates etc.*
- **Small electrical** - *such as kettles, microwaves, toasters, radios, slow cookers, vacuums*
- **Televisions** *including freeview boxes, old sky boxes*

As you can see it's an extensive list. Helen Meehan from Auckley is happy to take any of the items along each week. They can be left in the special labeled 'bin' by St Saviours, given to Helen, or for Finningley given to the service leader heading up to Auckley.
