Our Annual Memorial Service

Our service this year is on Sunday 30th October at 6.30pm in Finningley Church.

With more of us taking funerals this year ensuring we don't miss someones name is getting more complicated, and we really don't want to upset anyone by not including their loved ones name in a printed list. So, this year, we are asking everyone to fill in a small card with the name of their loved one on it, and these will then be brought forward and names read out in the service. If you aren't able to make the service, then there will be some to complete beforehand that can be left in church.

Toy Appeal

This year Finningley will be supporting the Salvation Army's 'Be a Star' Christmas toy appeal. With the cost of living rises many local children will not receive gifts this year, and so this allows us to support families locally. Please note they ask for new gifts.

0-3 years: dolls, teddy bears, cot mobiles, baby clothes, bath toys, CDs of suitable music and nursery rhymes, puzzles

3-5: dolls and action figures, cars, lorries, DVDs and CDs (music and nursery rhymes), colouring sets, pencils, crayons, books, puzzles

5-9: educational games & toys, stationery (colouring sets, pencils, crayons, school sets), CDs & family friendly DVDs, books, puzzles, wordsearch, crosswords

9-12: games and toys, stationery, DVDs, books, t-shirts, hair accessories, gloves, scarves, hats

13-16: books, make-up and toiletries (please try to ensure non-allergic ingredients if possible), gloves, scarves, hats, t-shirts, hair accessories and gift vouchers

Please bring your gifts to either Finningley or Auckley and we will ensure they are taken to the Salvation Army.

Remembrance Sunday Changes

The Police and DMBC will sadly no longer provide support for road closures on Remembrance Sunday. Local Parish Councils can still apply to close roads, but must prove they have employed a certified and competent traffic management company. The Royal British Legion have also said that they are unable to support any parades that do not comply with this requirement.

Employing such a company is expensive, and so locally the only road closure will immediately in front of the Blaxton War Memorial. This unfortunately means there will be no parade to Finningley Church or service afterwards. However, uniformed organisations are invited to place crosses on the airman's graves following the War Memorial Service.

Working with the Parish Councils we have arranged a Service of Remembrance, lasting around 20 minutes in Blaxton, starting at 10.50am, which broadly follows the same format as last year.
