Our Annual Memorial Service

Our service this year is on Sunday 30th October at 6.30pm in Finningley Church.

13-16: books, make-up and toiletries (please try to ensure nonallergic ingredients if possible), gloves, scarves, hats, t-shirts, hair accessories and gift vouchers



Remembrance Sunday Changes

The Police and DMBC will sadly no longer provide support for road closures on Remembrance Sunday. Local Parish Councils can still apply to close roads, but must prove they have employed a certified and competent traffic management company. The Royal British Legion have also said that they are unable to support any parades that do not comply with this requirement.

Employing such a company is expensive, and so locally we are only able to close the road immediately in front of the Blaxton War Memorial. This unfortunately means there will be no parade to Finningley Church or service afterwards.

Instead, the Parish Councils have asked if we can have a Service of Remembrance, lasting around 20 minutes in Blaxton, starting at 10.50am, which broadly following the same format as last year.
