

GDPR Privacy Policy

for Holy Trinity & St Oswald, Finningley and St Saviour, Auckley

Privacy Notice

Holy Trinity & St Oswald, Finningley and St Saviour, Auckley are committed to protecting your personal data and respecting your privacy in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

This notice explains what information we collect, how we use it, and your rights regarding your personal data.

Who We Are

Holy Trinity & St Oswald, Finningley and St Saviour, Auckley are Church of England churches serving their local communities.

For the purposes of data protection law, the churches act as the "Data Controller" for the personal information we collect.

What Information We Collect

The Oversight Minister may collect and store personal information including:

- Names
- Email addresses
- Telephone numbers

This information is collected only where it is necessary for church administration and communication.

How We Use Your Information

We use personal information to:

- Communicate about church services, events, activities, and pastoral matters
- Respond to enquiries
- Maintain church contact lists

Email communication is only sent where permission has been given.

Lawful Basis for Processing

We process personal data under one or more of the following lawful bases:

- Consent – where you have given permission for us to contact you
- Legitimate interests – for the administration and day-to-day operation of the churches

You may withdraw your consent at any time.

Sharing Your Information

Your personal information is treated confidentially.

We do not sell, share, or pass personal data to third parties.

Data Storage and Security

We take reasonable steps to ensure personal information is kept secure and protected against unauthorised access, loss, misuse, or disclosure.

Information is only retained for as long as necessary for church purposes.

Your Rights

Under UK GDPR, you have the right to:

- Request access to the personal data we hold about you
- Request correction of inaccurate information
- Request deletion of your personal data where appropriate
- Withdraw consent for communications at any time
- Complain to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) if you believe your data has been handled improperly
